OUR AIMS


- To promote high standards of planning and architecture in or affecting the area of benefit.

- To secure the preservation, protection, development and improvement of features of historic or public interest.

THE SOCIETY HAS...

- Repaired and maintained the Jubilee Clock and its belfry.
- Negotiated with Rother District Council (RDC) to secure a moratorium on building development at Barrack Hall Park for 125 years.
- Financed the redesign of the Park as a public open space, including improvements to the children's play area.
- Funded new brick pavements and new street lamps throughout the Old Town.
- Purchased the lease and landscaped the 'Esdaile Garden' situated behind the Church Street shops.
- Purchased a collection of over 1,000 vintage postcards showing the development of Bexhill and made them available on line.
- Negotiated with RDC for the lease on Manor Barn, and carried out major works including re-roofing, replacement oak window frames and doors, and refurbishment of the toilets and foyer.
- Over many years run the successful May Day and Christmas
 Events for the benefit of the Old Town and the wider community.
